RESIDENCY APPLICATION FOR TUITION PURPOSES

INSTRUCTIONS:

All students applying for in-state status must submit the attached Rhode Island College Residency Application for Tuition Purposes accompanied by the documentation listed below. Incomplete applications will be returned unless a written explanation is included for each item of documentation you are unable to provide. Classification as a resident student becomes effective with the beginning of the term following the determination of residency. The policy established by the Rhode Island Office of the Postsecondary Commissioner, by which petitions requesting in-state residency will be approved or denied, is rigorous.

Definitions (Office of Postsecondary Council):

For the purpose of determining in-state and out-of-state classifications, the word **residency** shall mean domicile: the legal, documented, true and permanent home and place of habitation. For the **dependent (unemancipated)** student, the domicile will be that of the parents and/or guardians (with the exception of individuals qualifying for federal GI Bill benefits as outlined in section C (3)). For the **independent (emancipated)** student, the domicile will be that of the student.

If you are claiming recognition as a **dependent (UNEMANCIPATED)** student, please provide a photocopy of each of the following items:

- Page 1 of your parents' Federal Income Tax Return for the most recent year—the first page only.
 - a. Both parents' (or if applicable, custodial parent or guardian) Rhode Island driver's licenses and vehicle registrations.
 - b. All Trusts, Wills, Support or Custody Decrees or Agreements affecting you.
 - c. Your parents' (or if applicable, custodial parent or guardian) current rental lease(s) or evidence of property ownership—first page and signatory page only.
 - d. A certified copy of your parents' (or if applicable, custodial parent or guardian) most recent R. I. State Income Tax Return.

- e. Notarized statement from the Town Clerk indicating the original date(s) of voter registration for both parents (or if applicable, custodial parent or guardian).

Please Note:

- a) Any **dependent (unemancipated)** student whose parents and/or guardians have been residents of the state for **one year immediately preceding the first day of class, of the first semester**, of the student's registration in a public college or university shall be classified as a resident student as long as the parents and/or guardians continue to be residents of the state.
- b) Any **dependent (unemancipated)** student who initially was classified as a non-resident student may thereafter obtain re-classification only if the student's parents and/or guardians establish and maintain residence in Rhode Island for **a period of at least one year prior to the first day of class, of the semester**, for which the student seeks to be re-classified as a resident student.
- c) The residency of a **dependent (unemancipated)** student, including those whose parents and/or guardians are divorced or legally separated, shall follow that of the parent or guardian who has legal custody or the parent or guardian who is responsible for the financial support of the student, whichever favors the student's request for resident student status.
- d) A **dependent (unemancipated)** student under guardianship shall be required to present satisfactory documentary evidence of the appointment of the guardian in addition to a certification of the residency of the guardian, which shall be considered the residency of the student unless there are circumstances indicating that such guardianship was created primarily for the purpose of conferring resident student status on the student.
- e) A **dependent (unemancipated)** student whose parent or guardian is a member of the Armed Forces and stationed in the state pursuant to military orders shall be entitled to the classification as a resident student during any semester in which the first day of class is encompassed by the orders.

If you are claiming recognition as an **independent (EMANCIPATED)** student, please provide a photocopy of each the following items:

- Your Federal Income Tax Return for the last two years—first page only.
- Your parents' Federal Income Tax Return for the last two years or a notarized statement from your parents that you were not claimed as a dependent on their Federal Income Tax Return for the last two years and that they have no intention of such claim in the future.
- A certified copy of your parents' (or if applicable, custodial parent or guardian) most recent State Income Tax Return.
- Your Rhode Island driver's license and vehicle registration(s).
- Current rental lease and leases—first and signatory pages only--covering your residency at address listed on the attached application. If formal leases are unavailable, a notarized statement from the landlord detailing dates and remittances may be substituted.
- Copies of all loan agreements in their entirety (signatures of all parties to these agreements)

must show clearly.)

- A notarized statement from the Town Clerk indicating the original date of your voter registration.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. Materials should be submitted as a single, complete packet.
2. Be sure to include a full explanation for each item of documentation not submitted.
3. Classification becomes effective with the beginning of the term following the determination of residency.
4. Study the regulations defining resident and non-resident students carefully. The burden of proof is upon the person making the claim.
